PREVIEW

- Use the U2L5 video.

CONNECT

- Introduce the concept of how being confident in their identities can help them live as the people God made them to be.
- Read the provided Scriptures from the Connect section.
- Focus on the identity statements that come from Scripture.
- Guide students to understand that they can find their true identities in God.

EXPLORE

- Guide students to respond to the provided identity statements.
- Allow time for worship, prayer, and reflection.
