

## LEADER GUIDE LESSON OUTLINE

**CONNECTION:** God can protect us from further harm.

**SCRIPTURE:** Psalms 25; 33:12-22; Proverbs 4

### SUPPLIES TO GET

whiteboard and dry-erase markers (or art paper, tape, and markers)  
pens, pencils, paper

### REMEMBER

“Guard my life and rescue me;  
do not let me be put to shame,  
for I take refuge in you.”  
Psalm 25:20

### PREVIEW

- Use the U3L10 video.
- Do the protection discussion activity.

### CONNECT

- Introduce the concept of how God’s wisdom can protect us from further hurt.
- Read the provided Scriptures from the Connect section.
- Focus on the idea that God protects us when we go to Him and rely on His guidance.
- Guide students to understand that God our protector teaches us how to live in godly ways. When we trust in Him and follow His way of living, He will help us protect our hearts and minds.

*\*Don’t forget to*

- use the ZOOM QUESTIONS to go deeper with older/more mature students.
- use the *Student Guides* or the Your View Conversation Cards to let students lead each other through part of the lesson.

### EXPLORE

- Read the principles and the Bible verse references.
- Give students time to read the Bible verses and respond to the principles.

*\*Don’t forget to* use this time for worship together, if desired.

### ACT

- Give students some closing thoughts and challenges to take them through the week.

- use the Family Connection materials provided on *Digital Resources* to connect with parents and caregivers about what the students are learning.
