Choose Well

***“Come, let us bow down in worship, let
us kneel before the Lord our Maker.”***

As I go through my day, I try to think of how the daily choices we make show that we put God first—and I share this with my kids: “I am making extra for supper tonight so that we can take it over to Mrs. Potts. She just got home from the hospital. That’s a way we put God first—by sharing what we have.” Point out to your kids the ways they are showing they put God first, too. “Hey! You did what I asked you to do, just like that! Thanks! You’re obeying, which makes me happy, but more than that, you’re showing you put God first!” “When you’re respectful to me even when you feel grumpy, you’re showing you put God first in your life. Thank you. That makes God glad, and makes me glad, too!”

Try This:

Here’s a simple “car game” to try: Give a hypothetical situation to your kids with the challenge to come up with a way to show they put God first in that situation. Here are some ideas: You want to go to your room and play video games, but your parent tells you to clean your room first. Your good friend invites you to go along to the amusement park, but it’s the same day your grandma will be visiting from out of state. Be sure to have them think of some situations for you to answer, as well! It’s not only fair; it’s also a great way to help them understand how to think through situations.
