God's Faithfulness Every Day

I cry out to God Most High, to God, who vindicates me.

Psalm 57:2

At mealtimes, we often talk about what's going on in the world and on the news. One of our kids loves these discussions, the other doesn't because he worries about the future and the economy, and wars and the suffering. To help them see events with a biblical worldview, we often tell our kids, **Our employers are not our providers, but God is our Source. We can depend on Him to take care of our needs. All the material possessions we have could be wiped out in a moment, but we would still have God with us, and we would follow Him. Life is more than the stuff we have and what we can accumulate. His plan for us is not in what we have but who we are.** Our mealtime prayers often include praying for God's help for those who are suffering and thankfulness for God's gift of eternal life. We continually need Him.

Try This:

One week our family read Psalm 57 every day together. Each day we personalized it by adding a time God showed His faithfulness to us. We started by recounting what we had added the days before and then added another one. By the end of the week, we were very familiar with what God's Word recorded about God and how involved He is in our lives.
