To help our kids learn to make wise choices we highlight examples of people making choices that affect others. The woman and her kids who drove 60 miles with a trailer load of household goods collected in their neighborhood for a family who lost everything in a fire. The therapists who work with a well-known woman to regain her abilities after an accident. **You can make a big difference when you choose wisely. God will help you keep His priorities.**
