Short Trips, Long Trips

God said, "I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go."

See Genesis 28:15

On days when I have several errands to run and the kids are along, I take a moment to draw a square or circle for each stop. (If I have time, I draw a simple picture for each—a milk jug for our grocery store stop; a shoe for the shoe store.) My preschooler colors in each square or circle as we finish that stop. Then he knows how many stops are left and when we can go home. At the top of the list I draw a pair of eyes, and say, **God will be with us wherever we go. He will take care of us."**

Try This:

The next time your family takes a trip, let your preschooler help with the packing. Make a game of taking turns saying why you need each item. You might say, "I will take my toothbrush so I can clean my toes." Your child corrects you to say why you take your toothbrush. Then he gives a silly reason for taking something else and you correct him.
