Sometimes it's easier to get the chores done when my child is taking a nap or over at her grandparent's house. But I want my child to develop an attitude of helping and taking responsibility for jobs. So it's worth it to plan times when my preschooler and I work on a job together. I say, **Let's do our best work. It shows our love for God, and for others, too!**

Try This:

After we have a snack or meal together, it would be easier and quicker for me to clean up, but I ask her to help. She might throw all the napkins away or collect all the utensils and put them in the dishwasher. I tell her, **You are a good worker. That's what God wants us to do.**
