Positive Friendships

Do good to all people.

Galatians 6:10

Preschoolers are beginning to show sympathy to others. They are sharing with others more, but still sometimes fight over toys. Here are some ways to help your child continue to develop positive friendships: Talk often with your child about thoughts, feelings, and needs of others. When you see your child being gentle or comforting another, or working out problems, say, **I like how kind you were with your friend. I'm glad you used your words when you were angry.** Show your child the simple words of this week's verse in your Bible.

Try This:

I want my preschooler to have regular opportunities to play with other children so we make it a priority to be at church every Sunday so he can be in a place with others his age and with loving teachers who help him learn to play.
