## Growing Up to Share

*Be kind to one another.*

See Ephesians 4:32

I love to see the ways God has planned for my child to grow! Sometimes, however, I wonder if getting along with others, especially brothers and sisters, without constant arguments will ever happen! I know it's all part of the process: Preschoolers grow in their play experiences, from playing with little interaction as toddlers to actively coordinating their activities by the time they go to kindergarten. To help your child grow socially and have more opportunities to practice sharing, provide a variety of toys and other objects that are good for group play, like balls and items for playing house and store. Say, **When you share with your friend, you are being kind.**

### Try This:

At bedtime, when I read Bible stories with my preschooler, I point out stories where people shared and were kind to others, like the boy who shared his lunch with Jesus, and Jesus who let the children come to Him.
