What Makes You Sing?

“My lips will shout for joy when I sing praise to you.”

Psalm 71:23

When my kids spontaneously sing out, I know they are happy or excited—their joy just overflows. I think God must love it when we erupt with a song of praise for Him because we just can't keep it in! To focus us on praising Jesus I might say, “Jesus loves me so much, it makes me want to sing!” Then I ask if they ever feel that way and we list the things He does for us: never leaves us alone, gives us strength and wisdom and peace, gives us the free (to us—costly to Him) gift of eternal life. It doesn't take long before we are refocused and excited by His amazing goodness and greatness!

Try This:

Especially during this season, try to read a Psalm every day. You might read during a mealtime or before bed. This Book is filled with expressions of praise for who our Creator is and the amazing things He has done. It's also filled with prophecies about Jesus and His death and resurrection—so you might want to include these and look for those prophecies and fulfillments: Psalm 118 for Palm Sunday, Psalm 41 for Maundy Thursday, Psalm 22 for Good Friday and Psalm 16 for Easter Sunday.
