Keep Learning

“He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths.”

Isaiah 2:3

When we stop learning, we stop growing. Let your kids see that you continue to learn new things, whether it is formally through classes or informally through other people, reading, or experience. I make sure to tell my kids when I have learned something from them—they think that’s pretty amazing! When you read your Bible and something pops out at you, tell your family about it. I even say, “I’ve read that many times before, but never saw that before.” This helps your kids realize that God’s Word is living and active and has something to tell them anytime they read it! Talk also with your kids about what you learn at church—be sure they understand that you listen to a sermon because you want to learn more about God and His ways so that you can do what He created you to do in this life. We want them to feel that all of us—kids, adults, old people—are all on this journey together. God wants us to learn from each other!

Try This:

Because my kids often cannot see it for themselves, I like to describe to them the ways I can see them learning and growing. “When you were younger, you had a hard time saying you were sorry when you’d hurt someone’s feelings. I’ve noticed that now, you do it easily and from your heart. I’m glad to see that you are learning God’s ways.” I know they love to hear it—and I love to tell them!
