## Better Than Money

***“Those who trust in their riches will fall, but the righteous will thrive like a green leaf.”***

Proverbs 11:28

Help your kid understand what trust is. We play “Trust/Don’t Trust” with our kids at mealtimes. We take turns to state, “I trust/don’t trust . . .” and then fill in a name (mom, the floor, my friend Joey), completing our turn by telling the reasons why we trust or don’t trust in what we named: “I trust mom to love me no matter what because I am her child.” “I trust this floor to hold me up because it is supported by strong materials.” “I don’t trust in money, because its value changes—and it’s easy to lose.” “I trust Jesus because He never fails.”

### Try This:

From the grocery store checkout to the TV ads, there are always times when I have to tell my kids we can’t buy something they want. I invite them to pray about it; as they ask God to show them how to get that thing, it often helps them to clarify just how important it is! I also remind them, “Because we’re part of God’s family, God will give us everything we need. In His family, we don’t need to worry. He will take care of us—and surprises us all the time with His gifts!”
