You Are Forgiven

*“You, Lord, are forgiving and good, abounding
in love to all who call to you.”*

Psalm 86:5

Others may tell me I am a patient parent but on the inside, I am NOT always the most patient parent. That’s the reason for one continual prayer: “God, help me to be more patient, loving, and forgiving, like You are.” When I mess up, I let my kids know. If I’ve hurt them, I ask their forgiveness. And I always tell them, **God still loves me! And when I ask, He forgives me.** I encourage my kids to talk about times it’s hard for them to believe that God loves and forgives them when they have done wrong.

Try This:

Sometimes kids find it hard to believe that their parents will love them when they do wrong. So after giving consequences to my kids for something they’ve done, I try to always follow up with this verbal reminder: **I love you. I want what’s best for you. That will never change. God loves you, too—always!**
