The Best Help

God will help you.

1 Chronicles 12:18

Preschoolers are such good helpers—put a duster in her hand and she will dust your whole house! Give him a broom and he will sweep the floors. I try to notice those times when my kids help and then tell them what great helpers they are. I say, **Just like you were so happy to help me, God is happy to help you!** I share ways I need His help to be kind or think of others or do my best work. I ask what ways they might need God's help. We pray, **Thank You, God, for Your help!**

Try This:

Rather than always taking charge of a situation with my kids or praying silently for God's help, I sometimes ask for His help aloud in front of them. As I buckle my preschooler in her car seat I might say, "God, please help me drive safely. Help my little girl be safe in this car. Thank You." This helps them to know that obeying God's Word and praying anytime is the normal thing to do!
