Share the Love

Jesus said, "Love each other as I have loved you."

See John 15:12

Doing small, surprising acts of love for family members takes extra effort—and sometimes, we get so used to living with each other that we can take each other for granted. When I think of something that might say “love” to a family member, I jot it down in a notebook. Every few days my preschooler and I pick an idea from the notebook and try to do that special surprise for that person. I tell my preschooler, **We show each other that we love each other because Jesus loves us.**

Try This:

We play a spontaneous game in our family called “Share the Love.” The person who is “It” goes a family member and expresses love in some way, (kiss on the cheek, high five, hug, etc.). The receiver then goes to another person and does the same thing until it passes to the last person, who becomes “It” and starts passing a new expression of love around the family!
