I try to share with my kids about ways God has helped me through hard times. I can look back and see how it all worked out. ! But I explain, **I didn't know the end when I was going through it.** I ask them when it might be hard for kids their age to remember God's love in a difficult situation. We also have a family prayer journal, so that we remember to pray for each other in our family for God's help through difficult and fearful times.
