Then she shared what she thought about why they were treated that way. We had a good discussion about being a friend to the friendless—that this is the way Jesus lived. We added these kids to our prayer list. After praying daily for them, my daughter told me that she was going out of her way to include them and encourage her friends to include them, too. I told her, **God watches over all of us—but especially those who are like strangers or newcomers. And He often wants to use us to show His love to them.**
