One Step at a Time

When I go for a walk with my kids, I explain that when we talk about “following Jesus,” it’s a lot like taking a walk with Him every day. The Bible refers often to “walking in His ways” or learning “His paths.” **When we obey God, we are going His way, which keeps keeps us getting closer to Him so we can walk and talk together. But when we disobey, it’s like walking off His path onto another path. Then we can’t walk and talk with Him. There are always consequences! Obeying God is good for us.**
