The Word for Kids

God's Word is for all ages. The best gifts I gave my kids when they were very little were Bible Story books at their level. They had lots of colorful pictures and the main stories of the Bible. We shared many hours reading them together. Those became their favorite books. Over the years my kids have gotten other Bibles at their level of reading and understanding. As teenagers, they are reading the Word on their own. But those worn Bible Story books still sit on our shelf and we occasionally reminisce about the times we spent reading them and building a foundation of faith by reading about God together.

Try This:

I read a Bible story to my preschooler and then she "reads" it, retelling what she heard in her own words. She usually looks at the pictures, points at them, and adds other details from what she sees. Then I read the story again. I let her choose which story we read next. I tell her, **God's Word is for everyone. You don't have to be grown up to learn from God. God will teach you how to live.**
