## Good Stuff!

*I will obey God's word.*  
See Psalm 119:17

This week, notice how many times your child obeys you. Tell her you will put a penny or cotton ball in a jar every time she obeys. As you put the penny in the jar say, **When you obey your parents, you obey God.** At the end of the day, count the pennies in the jar. Let her see if she can get more pennies tomorrow. Tell her, **Obeying God's Word helps you every day.** See if you notice an overall improvement of attitude in your home this week. Is your home a happier place to be? Are there more smiles, hugs, positive words—and more obedience?

### Try This:

At the end of summer, we go through the kids' clothes and toys, looking for things they've outgrown. One may like to discard stuff he's done with, while another wants to keep everything. But it's important that the kids be involved. Once things are boxed up (we tape boxes shut to avoid regretful looking!), we go together to take them to a place where they'll be shared with others who can use them. I tell my kids, **When we share things, we are obeying God's Word to share with others in need.**
