The Same as Yesterday

*The Lord is trustworthy in all he promises
and faithful in all he does.*

Psalm 145:13

As we make our plans for a summer day or for the week, I remind my kids, **This is our intended plan. Sometimes things change. We will have to be flexible!** When we get our hopes up for something, it's so disappointing when plans don't work out. Sometimes the change is weather-related or circumstances change. When we have to alter plans I say, **I'm glad we can depend on God to always do what He has said He would. He never changes. We know He will never leave us. He promised to prepare a place for us. And one day, He will come back to take us all there because He loves us and we belong to Him.**

Try This:

In our Bible reading journal, we have a section where we simply list God's characteristics and the Bible reference where we found that characteristic. During our Bible reading, the kids enjoy listening for these characteristics—it's almost like a treasure hunt! Then when we've got a pretty good list, we review it to remind ourselves of who God is.
