A Leader To Follow

After church, I asked my preteen to tell what he liked about his Sunday School teacher, the children's ministries leader and our pastor. Then I pointed out the leadership qualities I see in these people as well. I tell my kids, **I'm glad we have godly leaders. God put these people in our lives to help prepare us to do the things God has created us to do. I remind them, All of us are leaders in some way. We're at our best when we follow Jesus as our Leader and pattern our lives after Him.** I then point out the leadership qualities I see in my own kids. Who knows what amazing things God may do through them!

Try This:

At a mealtime or in the car, have fun imagining with your kids what the ultimate king and kingdom would be like. How would it look, feel, smell, sound and taste like? Compare your imaginary kingdom with what things you know about God's kingdom and Jesus as King. Remind your kids, **God's kingdom is ultimate and real. We are part of it now, even though we can't see it. That's why we sometimes feel conflicted in this world—we are just passing through here, on our way to His eternal Kingdom.**
