## Honest Communication

*Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.*

1 Corinthians 13:6

Thinking about what commercials, magazine ads, billboards are saying can help your kids think about honest communication. Companies want their products to look great so that we will buy them. Just because an ad says a shampoo will help you be popular doesn't mean it will. When we're watching TV, I ask, **Can you spot a commercial that is trying to trick you into thinking if you use the product you'll have fun, be attractive and have more friends? What might the commercial say if it was honest?** Then I ask, **How does honest communication in our family benefit us?** When we pray, I ask God's help in telling the truth.

### Try This:

I let my kids know that if they lie, they will have to continue to deal with it. If they will tell the truth—even when it's hard or they were wrong—the situation will become part of their past. Being honest always works out in their best interest.
