Praise and encouragement are important to children. As children grow,

they need to hear frequent positive messages from others to gain a balanced and healthy self-worth and to know what is right and good about the choices they make.

Sometimes being a good encourager takes practice. Try saying these to your child: "I believe in you!" "You have shown effort and that is important." "You can try again." How refreshed we feel when someone comes alongside us and says a few positive words that motivate and encourage us in our choices. Commit yourself to doing the same for your child.

Find this verse in a family Bible. Toss a ball back and forth. Whoever catches the ball can recite what the verse says about God's power and obeying Him.

This week, help your child remember:

Choices. Place two edible items under individual cups to hide them. One item should be something your child will view as a treat (a fruit snack or cookie). Show what is under the cup that wasn't chosen, and then show what is under the chosen cup. Talk about making choices. Pray and ask God to help your child make good choices.
