Basic Instructions

• 2 cups flour	1. Whisk butter, eggs, vanilla, and sugar together.	
• 1.5 tsp cinnamon	2. Add and combine flour, cinnamon, salt, oats, and optional add-ins.	
• 1 tsp salt	3. Roll the dough into 24 golf-ball sized rounds and place on cookie sheets lined with parchment paper.	
• 3 cups oats	4. Cook for 10 minutes or until edges begin to brown.
