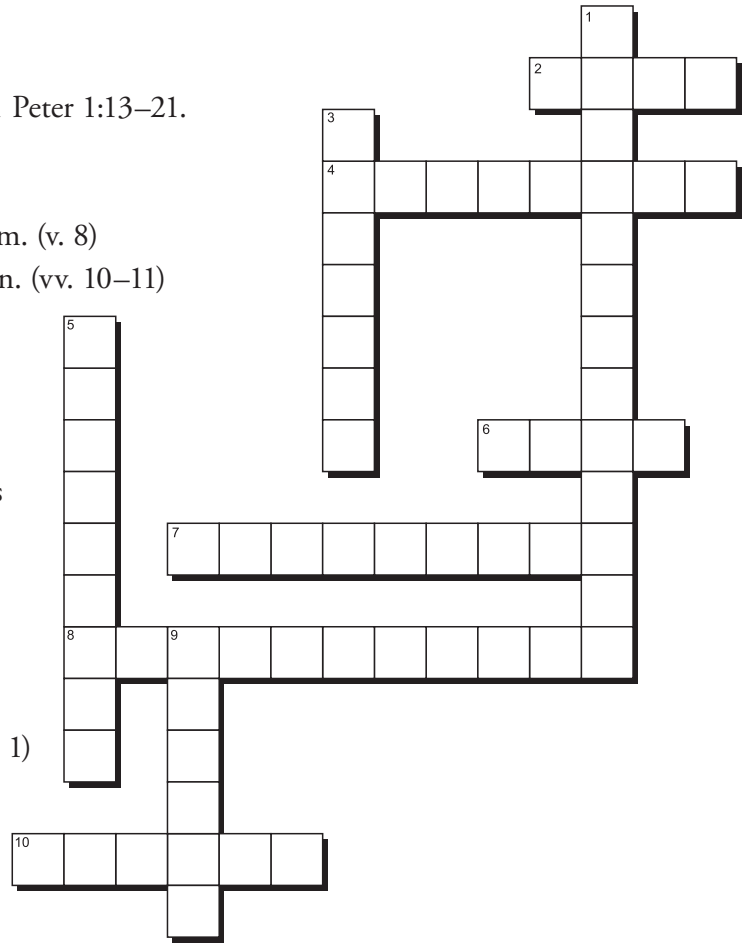
Complete the following crossword puzzle based on 1 Peter 1:13–21.
